**WHERE DOES YOUR MONEY GO?**

Wednesdays are Wonderful at PPC, but each Wednesday night costs both time and money. For every children's class, there are at least two adults at the helm. For every choir that sings, there are two adults and an accompanist as well. The kitchen crew boasts ten volunteers, and more are needed. Shane and Katie put in hours each preparing Bible studies and activities, and Room in the Inn uses eight or more volunteers each night. Meals cost between \$3.00 and \$3.50 each and, because money isn't formally collected each week, the program relies on limited church budgeted funds as well as donations from participants to cover the cost.

But the results are well worth it! Children learn Bible stories and music; youth grow closer to each other and to God; adults take a break from the chaos of the week to slow down, reflect, and pray; homeless neighbors are fed and given a warm place to sleep, and the presence of Christ is evident in all these things.

Whether you are a participant, a volunteer, or helper, thank you for taking time out of your week to celebrate who we are and what we believe. If you aren't currently coming on Wednesday nights – come check us out. You are likely to discover that Wednesdays really are Wonderful at PPC, and you will want to be a part of the excitement!
