I had the honor of presiding over a memorial service here at PPC this past weekend and the legacy the gentleman left to his family was rich in his love of music, a strong belief in encouraging others, and it was steeped in his faith and love for the Lord. He used to say something very powerful. He would tell people, especially his children, to “go and do the good things”. Not to go and do good, not to go and do things, but to go and do *THE* good things. The good things are the things that God calls us to do; the things we find in the scriptures. I really love that!

We are called as children of God and as the church to go and do the good things in the world. To love big. To treat each other with grace. To not be judgmental. That kind of love is radical. It cares for the things our neighbors care about, ALL our neighbors. It calls us to step outside of what makes us comfortable and reach out to our neighbors on the margins. It allows us the opportunity to be stretched and it moves us to where God needs us to be.

As I drove home from the memorial service, I begin reflecting on the power of those 6 words “go and do the good things”. I began to imagine a world where all of us, EVERYONE, was intentional about doing “the good things”. Imagine how much different that world would be. I also

wondered if that day would ever be possible. A day when every person regardless of race, religion, financial status, their past or their present would live out a life of intentional grace. Where handshakes are warm, words are spoken gently with love, and where each one of us felt tied to one another, responsible for each other’s well-being.

The doors of the church – all churches



– should always swing out and not in; out to a community that is need of the radical hospitality that God calls us to share with others. We are called to continue the work of Jesus. So many good are happening as we swing the doors open here at PPC. Thanksgiving dinner boxes will be going out to families in need in the community this month, we will be reaching out into the community and welcoming families in for the community Christmas party, 225 Christmas trees will be given away with

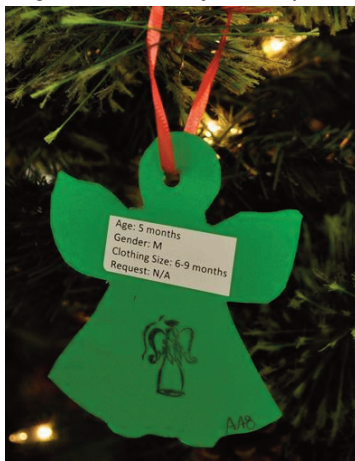

Over these five years, these knitters have made 752 items – shawls, hats, scarves and 2nd graduation gifts – while spending countless hours knitting and praying for those in need.

News from the Endowment Council...

In 1994, Jim and Cora Lee Lonon established a Scouting Endowment with the Presbyterian Church (USA) Foundation and Philadelphia Endowment Council through a Deferred Giving Program.



During the lifetime of the donors, the interest from the money they invested would go to the donors. After the death of both donors, the interest and remaining principal would go to an endowment for the Scouting Program here at the church.

Even though Cora Lee lived twenty five more years, this year the Endowment Council is happy to announce that more than \$13,000 remains in the fund and has been given by the Presbyterian Foundation to the Endowment Council.



It was the desire of Jim and Cora Lee that other members of the congregation would contribute to this fund which will provide financial help for scouting needs. We have a very active scouting program which includes Boy Scouts, Girls Scouts, and Cub Scouts. Boy Scouts were first chartered by Congress in 1910 and by 1914 Philadelphia had a Boy Scout Troop, one of the first in Mecklenburg County, by 1956 a Girl Scout Troop was formed, and Cub Scouts soon followed.

Help support Jim and Cora Lee's dream by growing the Philadelphia Presbyterian Church Scouting Endowment Fund which began with an idea and action twenty five years ago and today is a reality thanks to two benevolent people.

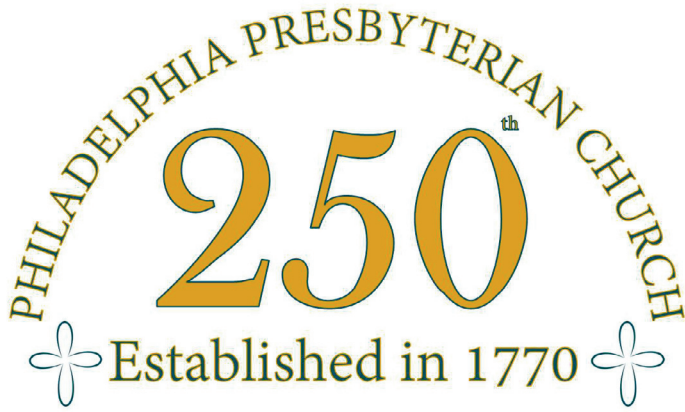
